Programme on Sustainable Group Mode of Financing **September 09-12, 2019 in Collaboration with BIRD Lucknow**

In view of the increasing importance of providing finance through group approach to marginal & weaker sections including farmers and others for livelihood activities, IIBM collaborated with BIRD Lucknow and organized the captioned program. Shri M K De and Shri A C Sarmah, Members of Faculty from BIRD coordinated the program. The

participants for the program included representatives from State Rural Livelihoods Missions, Banks & Financial Institutions, RRBs, Cooperatives and Small Finance Banks. The program included a visit, apart from interactive sessions. The program was well received and highly appreciated by all the delegates.



Programme for Auditors of Urban Co-Operative Banks
(September 16-17, 2019)

A two-day training on “Programme for Auditors of Urban Co-Operative Banks” was conducted from September 16-17, 2019. Twenty-four officers of various North Eastern states attended the programme. The main objective of the programme was to sensitize participants about the challenges before UCBs, PML and KYC, balance sheet analysis, understanding profit and loss account, prudential norms, IRAC, ALM and investment management etc. Dr. Pinky Dutta, Faculty IIBM, coordinated the programme.



Certificate Course for Debt Recovery Agents
(September 16-28, 2019)

IIBM has been conducting training programmes for the Debt Recovery Agents since 2009 under the title “Certificate Course for Debt Recovery Agents”. As a recognized center, IIBM has been conducting these programs on behalf of Indian Institute of Banking and Finance (IIBF). This Certificate Course in which 100 hrs of class-room learning is mandatory before taking online examination conducted by IIBF. It may be emphasized that only after successful completion of the 100 hours training program, the participants are permitted to take the online examination. Apart from certificate from IIBM for completing 100 hours training, the participants will also receive final certification from IIBF subject to securing minimum marks in the examination. The main objective of the programme is to ensure that the participants are equipped with the operational aspects of commercial banking with special focus on structure of Indian banking system and their functions, deposit accounts, banker customer relationship, various types of loans, legal aspects of banking, cheques and its features, retail products, NPA, KYC norms, regulatory framework for debt recovery, communication skills, etc. The programme Coordinator was Shri B A Lashkar and fifteen participants attended the programme.



IIBM's Collaborative Programme with USTM
(September 19-26, 2019)

IIBM has recently collaborated with the Department of Commerce, University of Science of Technology Meghalaya (USTM) and conducted a one-week short term certification course on “Management of Financial Services” during 19-26 September, 2019. The course was designed to equip the present post graduate and undergraduate students of the Department of Commerce with in-depth and practical understanding of Banking and Finance. In the certification course, the faculty members from IIBM including the Director delivered lectures on various topics on banking and finance.
