**Master Trainers Training Programme under Re-SVAYEM Scheme
(Govt of Assam) with collaboration with IIE
Dec 21, 2020 to Jan 8, 2021**

For the first time, IIBM collaborated with Government of Assam and IIE Guwahati and conducted six Master Trainers Training Programme under Re-SVAYEM Scheme in the districts of Lakhimpur (Dec 21-25, 2020), Nagaon (Dec 21-25, 2020), Sonitpur (Dec 28, 2020 to Jan 1, 2021), Udalguri (Dec 28, 2020 - Jan 1, 2021), Darrang (Jan 4-8, 2021) and Biswanath (January 4-8, 2021). The programme was coordinated by Dr. K Ramesha, Director, IIBM, Shri A K Bajpai, Faculty, IIBM, Dr. P Dutta, Faculty, IIBM, Shri K R Chandra, Faculty, IIBM, Shri A K Bajpai, Faculty, IIBM and Dr. P Dutta, Faculty, IIBM respectively.

The programmes aimed at creating a pool of trained Master Trainers for conducting training programs for the beneficiaries of R-SYAYEM. The larger objective of the R-SAYEM was to create employment opportunities, especially for the rural youth by utilizing the local resources for rural upliftment. The programme was attended by 42, 34, 26, 17, 18 and 34 government officials in the above district head-quarters respectively. Apart from inhouse faculty, a number of local entrepreneurs and resource persons from different organizations handled sessions.
